S.A. Reference Committee of Regions

- To ensure a consensus of S.A. positions on water and riparian issues, South Australian regions have set up a reference body where all 4 state regional representatives meet to establish consensus agreement on state MDA issues and general policy, serve the Board and staff when required and if possible to ensure support of issues of our interstate regions.
- To act as the representative body of the S.A. Regions along with the General Manager when dealing with State Government Ministers and state and SA federal members.
- The regions retain their autonomy and their right to dissent without prejudice.
